## **Dog Policy for Baraga Sanctuary**

If you are holidaying with your furry loved one, it is important that you have an understanding of our pet policy to know the expectations we set for our guests with pets.

- We welcome small to medium sized dogs (i.e. less than 20 kilograms) and a maximum of one dog at the property during your stay.
- Pets are strictly by <u>application only</u>. If you would like to apply for your pet to stay, please contact the Booking Agent at:

- If pets/animals are found at the premises without approval, you may become liable for the cost of cleaning the premises. There may also be a review of stay which could result in the termination of your stay.
- We highly recommend that your dog is current with its flea/tick treatments before arriving as the Barragga Bay area is surrounded by bushland.
  - There are a number of decent tick treatments available to protect your dog if in doubt contact the Bermagui Veterinary Clinic: telephone: 6493.4813 - Shop 4/1 Wapengo Street, Bermagui NSW 2546.
- Please be advised that this holiday let does not have a secure, fenced boundary to prevent your dog from roaming away from the property. Additionally, it is not unusual to have other animals/wildlife (e.g., kangaroos) traffic through the property.

## **Property Rules**

- Dogs must not be left alone or unsupervised inside the holiday accommodation or anywhere outside the property at any time.
- Dogs are not permitted upstairs, nor on the furniture (beds, chairs etc.)
- Please note any dog hair found on bedding will incur an additional cleaning fee
- Please be respectful of the neighbours and prevent your dog from excessive barking.
- Dog owners must make their own sleeping arrangements for their pets, i.e. bring their own dog bed.
- Dog owner responsibilities include cleaning up after your pet poos or is sick.
- We do not provide any amenities for your pet. Dog owners are expected to provide their own pet meal/water bowls, towels to rub the dog down, toys/ball, poo bags, restraint leads and bedding etc.
- If any accidental damage occurs, please just let us know so we can fix it for the next guests.

You can enjoy walking your dog on Cuttagee Beach, as it is a dog leash-free area from the south end of the beach to just before the lake entrance. Please note that the northern end of Cuttagee Beach is a Wildlife Protection Area, where dogs are prohibited at all times by order of the local council.
